AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE 149.09 RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS REMOVING THE CHIEF OR ACTING CHIEF OF POLICE FROM RESIDING WITHIN THE CITY.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Williamsport as follows:

SECTION 1: Section 149.09 (4)(i) is hereby amended to read as follows:

The following persons shall be required to reside within the City: Director or Acting Director of Administration, Director or Acting Director of Finance and Personnel, Director or Acting Director of Public Services, Director or Acting Director of Economic and Community Development, Director or Acting Director of Streets and Parks, Director or Acting Director of Public Safety, Chief or Acting Chief of Police, Chief or Acting Chief of the Fire Bureau, General Manager or Acting General Manager of the Bureau of Transportation, Personnel Manager or Acting Personnel Manager, City Engineer or Acting City Engineer, Codes Administrator or Acting codes Administrator, Deputy Treasurer, Deputy Controller and City Clerk or Acting City Clerk. The residency requirement established by this Subparagraph shall not apply to the following persons, provided a Director or Acting Director of Public Safety is employed by the City: A Chief or Acting Chief of the Fire Bureau. In the event that the City is not employing a Director or Acting Director of Public Safety or has otherwise eliminated said position, the Residency Requirement established by this subsection shall again apply to the Chief or Acting Chief of the Fire Bureau, and said person shall become resident of the City within 240 days from the date the City is no longer employing a Director or Acting Director of Public Safety. The residency requirement established by this subparagraph shall not apply to the Chief of Police if the Chief was not an employee of the Bureau of Police of the City of Williamsport at the time the individual was named Chief of Police, regardless of the employment status of the Director or Acting Director of Public Safety.

SECTION 2: Except as provided in this Ordinance, the remaining provisions of ARTICLE 149 shall remain in full force and effect.
