AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE
EAST THIRD STREET GATEWAY REVITALIZATION ADVISORY COMMISSION;
PROVIDING FOR THE MANNER OF
APPOINTMENT; SETTING FORTH
THE PURPOSE; DUTIES AND
LIMITATION ON EXPENDITURES

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Williamsport as follows:

SECTION 1 – CREATION

The East Third Street Revitalization Gateway Advisory Commission is hereby created for the City.

SECTION 2 – MEMBERSHIP: TERM

- (a) The East Third Street Revitalization Gateway Advisory Commission shall consist of seven (7) members who shall be residents of the City and appointed by the Mayor with the advice and consent of City Council.
- (b) The initial term shall be as follows: Three (3) members for a five (5) year term; and four (4) members for a four year term. Thereafter appointments to the Commission shall be for five year terms.
- (c) Vacancies in the Commission occurring otherwise than by expiration of

term shall be for the unexpired term and shall be filled in the same manner as the original appointments.

SECTION 3 – PURPOSE

- (a) The Commission shall be advisory to the Mayor and City Council on the revitalization of the east end of the City from Penn Street to the city line (Catherine Street) and from Washington Boulevard South to the Susquehanna River. The duties of the Commission will include but not be limited to examining the effects of zoning, planning, parking, and the seeking of grants and other sources of funding for this area of the City.
- (b) City boards commissions, authorities are authorized and directed to cooperate with and assist the Commission.
- (c) The Commission is authorized to create advisory sub-committees and appoint its members one of whom shall be a member of City Council.

SECTION 4 – EXPENDITURES

- (a) The Commission shall not be authorized under any circumstances to enter into any contracts on behalf of the City or itself or in any way bind the City with payment of any monies.
- (b) The Commission shall not be authorized to enter into any employment contracts.

SECTION 5 – EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall become effective twenty days after final enactment.
