



General Information: The 2017 Streat Food Festival is taking place on Saturday, May 6th at 1 Maynard Street from 10am to 8pm.

Space Assignments: Booth locations will be determined a month prior to the festival once all accepted applications are processed. Considerations will be based on competing food categories and time of submission of application.

Permits: It is the vendor's responsibility to acquire all needed city and state permits for onsite activation. It is required that all food vendor's submit proof of liability insurance naming Bayard Printing and the City of Williamsport as additional insured for the day of the event/property. The Streat Food Festival will do its best to aid in this process.

Menu: Every truck must serve at least one "taste" sampler item. Your "taste" item must be a "Taste-size" portion of one item that you are serving at the event. Food tuck/vendors may sell soft drinks and water. There will be beer sampling through the Billtown Brewers Guild.

Ground Surface and Weather: The Streat Food Festival is an outdoor event with some locations on concrete or grass. There can sometimes be locations that are not level. Please be sure to bring truck levels and indicate whether your on-site activation has specific needs in this case. Regardless of ground surface, we do require that all tents have 25lb weight on each leg for safety in windy weather. The Streat Food Festival will take place rain or shine, please be prepared for all kinds of weather.

Available Resources: Food trucks and vendors must be able to operate independently of any provided resources at this event location including water, electric, etc. Food trucks and vendors are to provide their own products, personnel, signage, décor, and any pop-up tents.

Set-up/Teardown: Once you are parked, at your designated location, you will not be able to move until the completion of the event. Truck/vendors who are unable to reach the event by set-up time on the event day may not be permitted to participate in the event. Any requests for special provisions regarding this policy may be received by Jessie Novinger *two weeks prior* to the event. Exhibitors should arrive for set-up between 7am- 8:30am on Saturday, May 6th and must be prepared for patrons by 10am

when event begins. There will be no teardown prior to 8pm. Trucks/vendors will be released for departure no sooner than 30 minutes after the conclusion of the event.

Trash/ Clean-up: The trash containers provided throughout the event space are for the attendees, do not stuff those containers with any large items. Use discarded boxes to store trash until the event is over, if necessary. All participants are responsible for clean-up of their space and immediate surrounding area of said space. All cardboard must be broken down neatly and flattened. Any oil and/or grease must be disposed of properly at an off-site facility. Any water or liquid must be disposed of properly into a designated drain. Do not dump ANYTHING where you are parked.

Payment: Exhibitor payments must be received with the application. All checks can be made payable to The City of Williamsport (Street Food Festival in memo line). **Must be received by April 7, 2017.** You can mail the check to:

Food and non-food vendors have 15 days from the submission of application to cancel and receive a full refund of your festival vendor fee. Cancellation after the 15 day period will forfeit 100% of your application fees.
