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Pool Rules

1. Smoking and/or Tobacco and/or e-cigarettes use is NOT PERMITTED on Pool or Park Property.
2. Physical violence, and threats of violence toward staff or other patrons will result in your eviction for the day and may result in your suspension for the summer.
3. Profanity, vulgarity and verbal abuse won't be tolerated and will result in at least a one day suspension
4. Charges will be filed against anyone who attempts to enter Pool Property without paying.
5. If the Police have to be called to escort you from the Pool Property, you will be suspended for the summer.
6. Alcohol or other drugs are NOT PERMITTED on Pool Property! You will be suspended for the summer and the Police will be contacted regarding your illegal activity.
7. Glass Bottles are NOT PERMITTED on Pool Property.
8. Children under the age of 13 must be accompanied by someone of the age of 18.
9. Adult Swims are for patrons over the age of 18.
10. Only proper fitting U.S. Coast Guard approved lifejackets are permitted. Do not bring any other type of flotation device into the facility.
11. Running on the cement or horseplay of any kind is NOT PERMITTED.
12. No eating or drinking on the Pool Deck.
13. Use of cameras and/or visual recording devices are prohibited in the bathhouse.
14. Use a feet first entry into water less than 10 feet deep. NO DIVING.
15. Respect the Pool Property and Staff Members.
16. Proper swimsuits must be worn. Cutoffs, streets clothes, jeans, etc. are NOT PERMITTED in the Pool or Slide.
17. Must be 48" in to use the slide.
18. Everyone entering Splash Cove must pay. No refunds or rain checks will be issued.
19. Children under the age of 8 years old must be accompanied in the water, by adult, and be within arm's reach of the adult at all times.
20. Failure to comply with these rules will result in Police being contacted and/or suspension from Pool Property for the summer.
21. All patrons under the age of 18 must be swim tested before you enter the pool.
22. City of Williamsport and Splash Cove is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged property.
23. **No refunds for any reason.**



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Health and Safety Rules

1. Everyone shall take a cleansing shower before using the pool and after bathroom breaks.
2. Anyone who is ill and/or has had diarrhea in the past 14 days shall not use the pool.
3. Anyone who has an open wound, open blisters, cuts, etc. is advised not to use the pool.
4. Drinking, spitting, spouting water, blowing the nose and similar behavior is prohibited.
5. Children who are not toilet trained must wear either a swim diaper or tight fitting plastic pants with elastic legs and waist.
6. Do not change diapers on the pool deck, use the bathhouse. Change diapers often and wash your hands before returning to the pool.

Water Slide Rules

1. LARGE WATER SLIDE-All slid users must be at least 48 inches tall, no more than 300 pounds and be able to swim to the ladder.
2. JUNIOR WATER SLIDE-You must be less than 40 inches tall to use this slide.
3. Only one person on the slide at a time.
4. Wait for the guard signal or instruction before entering the slide.
5. Ensure the slide and slide exit area is clear.
6. You must slide feet first in either a sitting position or on your back.
7. No lifejackets, jewelry, eyeglasses keys, toys, floating devices, shirts sippers or buttons and etc.
8. Do not attempt to catch anyone coming down the slide.
9. Exit the slide immediately.

Diving Board Rules

1. Everyone using the diving board must wear a blue band and be able to swim.
2. One person on the diving board at a time.
3. Make certain the diving area is clear.
4. Swim to the nearest ladder and exit the pool.
5. Dive straight off the board. No back or inward dives.
6. Only one bounce on the board.

I have read and understand all rules and policies. Failure to comply with all rules and policies will terminate your season pool pass and will affect further season pool passes.
