INVITATION FOR BIDS

Sealed proposals will be received electronically via PennBid until the date and time listed above, Eastern Standard Time. This contract is for the City of Williamsport's **BITUMINOUS ASPHALT PAVING CONTRACT AND RELATED PORTLAND CEMENT CONCRETE WORK (INCLUDING ADA RAMPS)**, for the 2022 construction season.

One important note to all potential bidders, that ensures that a quality paving service is provided: *The paving contractor MUST BE PENNDOT PREQUALIFIED for asphalt paving in order to bid on this project, for two reasons 1) PennDOT State Funding is involved and 2) Ensures a quality product for the City of Williamsport*

A cashier's check or an acceptable bidder's bond, payable to the City of Williamsport, Pennsylvania, in an amount of not less than ten (10%) percent of the largest possible total for the bid submitted, must accompany the bid.

Notice is hereby given that this is a Section 3 Project under the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1968, and must, to the greatest extent feasible, utilize lower income residents for employment and training opportunities and Section 3 Business Concerns and that all contracts and subcontracts for this project shall contain the "Section 3 Clause" as set forth in 24 CFR Part 135.38. Prime contractors are advised of their obligation to utilize minority, women and Section 3 subcontractors in the execution of the contract to the extent possible. Failure to demonstrate compliance with outreach requirements will result in the City's rejection of a bid.

As used in this Notice, and in the contract resulting from this solicitation, the "covered area" is the Williamsport Metropolitan Area – Lycoming City. Prime contractors will be required to submit a Business Utilization Table, Table of Work Force Needs and a Manpower Utilization Training Table to meet Section 3 requirements.

It is the policy of the City of Williamsport to strongly encourage the use of Minority Business Enterprises (MBE's) in contracts utilizing funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.

Bidders may not be on the comptroller general's list of ineligible contractors. The successful bidder will be required to comply with all applicable equal opportunity laws and regulations. The Contractor will be subject to the requirements of Executive Order Nos. 11246 and 11375.

This project is a Prevailing Wage Project under Davis-Bacon Wage Rates and the Federal Labor Standards Provisions applicable to contracts covering federally-financed and assisted construction shall apply.

There is not anticipated to be a pre-bid conference for this project, as the City will utilize the built-in question and answer capabilities of PennBid. If this changes, it will be added via addendum, on PennBid.

The City reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive irregularity in the Bids and in the Bidding. No bid may be withdrawn until the expiration of ninety (90) days from the date bids are opened.



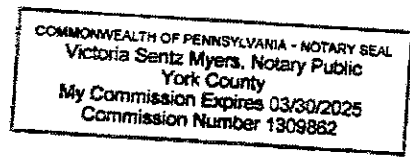
