AN ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WILLIAMSPORT, COUNTY OF LYCOMING AND THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA FIXING THE TAX RATE FOR ALL CITY PURPOSES FOR THE YEAR 2023

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLIAMSPORT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I:

A real property tax is hereby levied on all persons and property within the said City subject to taxation for general city purposes for the fiscal year, as follows:

Tax rate for the year 2023 for general city purposes, the sum of 16.22 mills (16.22/1000) on each one-dollar of assessed valuation.

<u>Purpose</u>	<u>Mills on each dollar of assessed valuation</u>	<u>Cents on each one-hundred dollars of assessed valuation</u>
Total – All Purpose	16.22	\$1.622

SECTION II:

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION III:

Whoever fails, neglects or refuses to pay the real property tax within four months of the date of the tax notice shall be charged a penalty of ten percent which penalty shall be added to the taxes and collected by the Tax Collector.

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


